Residential Program volunteering

Our residential program offers 24/7 care to young moms and moms in recovery, and their babies. Volunteering in the residential program can look like

- babysitting kiddos
- providing support for the moms
- helping cook meals
- mentoring
- other close 1-on-1 care.

Volunteering for this program is a long-term commitment for responsible and dependable community members who intend to make lasting relationships with the families in our care.

To volunteer here you will need to fill out paperwork and submit a background check

Child Enrichment Center - Preschool

Our Pre-K program has children from 0-5 years of age.

Volunteering with them might include

- reading to the kiddos
- cooking
- gardening
- crafts
- and sharing other hobbies and skills.

This type of volunteering is a long-term commitment as well.

To volunteer here you would need to complete paperwork, a background check, and submit your vaccination records.

Life Skills Classes

We offer volunteer-run life skills classes for our clients with topics ranging from taxes, to voting, to knitting, to mechanics, and more. If you have a special skillset that you would like to share with our clients, this is the right type of volunteering for you. No background check or other paperwork is required but you will need to provide proof of experience in your topic and do a short interview.

Events and Other

We have several events and projects throughout the year that we need manpower for such as running a raffle table at a fundraising event, reorganizing shelves, signing cards, and more. Projects come up sporadically and your commitment and availability can be flexible. No paperwork or background check is required.
